Help invite neighbors to upcoming community events.

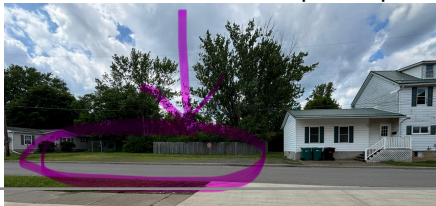
- 11:00 a.m. – Distribute Block Party flyers along 2nd Avenue.
